



Nutrition project for the conditional cash transfer component of nutrition

In a dire situation, food aid has become an important source of food support for millions of Yemenis. HUMAN ACCESS contributes to the provision of food aid through the nutrition project, the cash transfer component, funded by WFP. About 10,500 beneficiaries (pregnant and lactating) mothers receive cash assistance on a monthly basis in the districts of Al-Maqatirah, Habeel Jabr and Radfan in Lahj Governorate.
