



Response to Emergency & Acute needs of Communities and IDPs in Hard to reach areas

This project aims to enhance the health condition and life-saving interventions by providing minimum quality health services to the most vulnerable IDPs and host communities in remote areas in Maqbanah district, Taiz governorate. It provides its health services through two health facilities and a mobile medical team. The most notable services are the Minimum Service Package (MSP) which supports the provision of primary health care and integrated management of childhood illnesses, and the expanded vaccination programme and reproductive health services.
