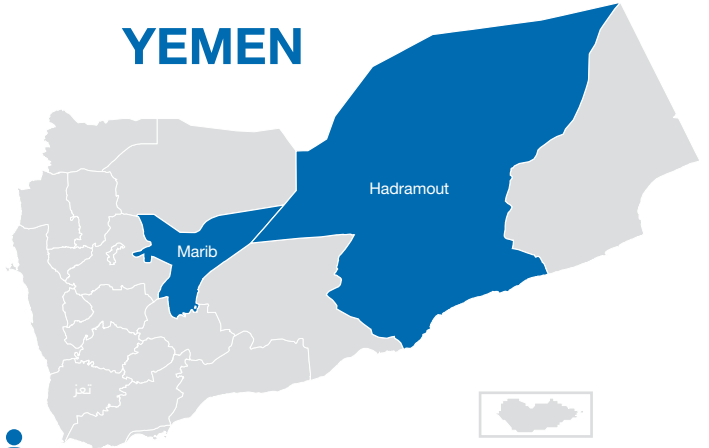
## SHELTER RESPONSE PROJECT

The project, implemented by HUMAN ACCESS and funded by YHF, contributed to alleviating suffering and reducing the risks of displacement through an urgent humanitarian response in priority areas for the most vulnerable groups and host communities through the distribution of non-food items to 300 families. Each item package consists of (7 mattresses, 7 blankets, 2 mats, 12 cooking pots, 5 plates, 2 water buckets, 5 cups, 7 spoons, and other cooking utensils).

Another 580 families also benefit from the cash rental subsidies, and each family receives an amount of 100 US\$ per month.

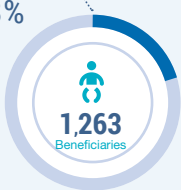

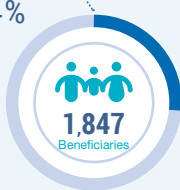

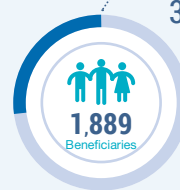

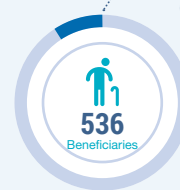
